- The Board of Directors is responsible for overseeing the management of our business and strives
 to ensure an appropriate balance between environmental responsibility and Dedalus's business
 goals. Dedalus is committed to operating in a manner that protects the environment of
 communities in which we conduct business.

Applicability (Scope)

This policy applies worldwide to all directors, officers and employees of Dedalus and its subsidiaries and affiliated entities, and Dedalus contractors wherever they are conducting work for and on behalf of Dedalus globally.

Requirements

Dedalus policy commits to reducing our impact on the environment through:

- Mitigating climate change through cleaner energy, where practicable, and managing emissions effectively
- Reducing waste generation, increasing recycling rates and working with suppliers to minimize waste and harmful environmental impacts upstream and downstream
- Promoting resource efficiency (energy, water, etc.) in our solutions and services, and within our supply chains
- Company commitment to pollution prevention and the proper use of natural resources.
- Designing solutions and services to optimize their environmental performance
- Addressing travel-related emissions

Compliance obligations

Dedalus aims to meet or exceed all applicable compliance obligations, client commitments and other requirements to which Dedalus subscribes.

This includes corporate reporting under recognized industry initiatives. Note, the corporate reporting may be undertaken at the Dedalus Group of companies rather than at the individual entity level.

Goals and objectives

Internal and external issues

Dedalus considers to be "issues" those factors or conditions that define the context in which it operates its business. Dedalus will determine the key relevant internal and external issues that could have an impact on Environmental performance, including:

- External cultural, social, political, legal, regulatory, financial, technological, economic, natural and competitive circumstances
- Internal characteristics or conditions of the company

Training

Dedalus will regularly provide appropriate training and awareness, supervision and support for EHS management systems.

Audit/Assessments

Dedalus will conduct third-party audits and organize self-assessments in support of Dedalus's Global EHS Management System Standard.



Supplier assessments

Dedalus will conduct third-party audits and organize self-assessments on our key suppliers with respect to their EHS performance in support of Dedalus policies and procedures. Dedalus will consider the results of these assessments when procuring goods and services.

Continual improvement

Dedalus is committed to the continual improvement of its environmental performance.
