



Dedalus officially opens new Irish headquarters

Minister for Enterprise and IDA Ireland CEO join Dedalus leadership to mark company's expansion

8 July 2026: Dedalus Ireland today officially opened its new Irish headquarters at Northwood Business Park, Dublin, at an event attended by Peter Burke TD, Minister for Enterprise, Tourism and Employment, alongside Michael Lohan, CEO, IDA Ireland, and Counsellor Edoardo Berionni Berna, Deputy Head of Mission, Embassy of Italy in Ireland.
